

Facts About Suicide

- Nevada has the 11th highest rate of suicide in the United States, nearly double the national rate.
- Suicide is the 10th leading cause of death in the United States, but is the 6th leading cause of death for Nevadans.
- Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for Nevada teens (10-34)
- For every teen that dies by suicide, it is estimated that 100-200 teens have attempted. One of the biggest risk factors for completed suicide is a previous attempt.
- More people die from suicide than homicide in the US.
- Nevada has the highest elder suicide rate in the country
- Suicide is the 6th leading cause of death for native Americans.
- Veterans comprise an estimated 20% of all completed suicides.
- Female Nevada veterans are 3 times more likely to die by suicide than the general Nevada female.
- Each suicide leaves at least six to eight bereaved family and friends.
- Surviving family members not only suffer the grief and trauma of losing a loved one to suicide, but also are themselves at higher risk for suicide and emotional problems.
- Discussing suicide does not cause someone to die by suicide
- Reducing access to lethal means can prevent suicide


